Oral Exam Instructions. Describing Your Clothes

Objective: To assess students' ability to describe their clothing using simple sentences, appropriate vocabulary, and basic grammatical structures.

Instructions for Students:

1. Individual Preparation

- Reflect on the clothes you are wearing today.
- Think about how they look, their colors, and sizes.
- Prepare four simple sentences describing your attire.

2. Speaking Activity (5 minutes):

- Student A begins by sharing their four sentences with Student B.
- Student B listens attentively and may ask simple follow-up questions if clarification is needed.
- After Student A finishes, Student B shares their four sentences.
- Student A listens and may also ask simple follow-up questions.

Example Sentences:

- "I am wearing a blue shirt. It is medium size."
- "My jeans are black and fit me well."
- "I have on white sneakers. They are size 9."
- "My jacket is red and very warm."

Assessment Criteria:

- **Vocabulary Usage:** Use of appropriate clothing-related words.
- **Sentence Structure:** Formation of correct and simple sentences.
- **Pronunciation:** Clarity and understandability of spoken words.
- **Comprehension:** Ability to respond to or ask simple questions for clarification.
