If you have ever been to a busy city, you will have seen technology all around. You will have seen skyscrapers and power plants and apartment buildings. You will have seen all manner of infrastructure. Quite often what makes these things work are things that you can't see - hidden things - that are under the ground.

In New York, for example, if you looked under the ground, you would find over 78,000 miles of electrical cables beneath the streets. These are crucial. They help **drive** the devices in the buildings and ensure the infrastructure above the ground works like clockwork.
