Artificial intelligence is changing the way students learn. Some AI tools can explain grammar, suggest new words, check pronunciation, and create practice questions. These tools are useful because they give quick feedback and allow learners to study at their own speed. For students who are shy in class, practising with a digital assistant may also make them more confident.

Nevertheless, AI tools cannot replace teachers. A teacher understands students' emotions, notices their habits, and chooses activities that fit the class. In addition, students may become passive if they ask AI for every answer. They need to check information carefully because AI can sometimes give *inaccurate* or unsuitable responses.

The best approach is to use AI as a study partner. Students can ask for examples, practise speaking, and review mistakes. However, they should still think independently, take notes, and discuss difficult points with teachers and classmates. Responsible use of technology can make learning more effective.
