New and old fashions

There are lots of ways to buy clothes these days. You can buy them in a department store in your town or order something online from a country on the other side of the world. One thing that is becoming popular is buying second-hand or used items. (1) ____ Now they're selling them and there are probably lots of people who want to buy them.

One reason for buying second-hand clothes is that it's a good way to recycle clothes people don't want anymore. Perhaps someone is bored with the item of clothing.
