Biofuels: Pros and Cons

Biofuels are fuels produced from living matter such as plants. For example, substances can be extracted from corn and soybeans and then made into a fuel that can power cars or other vehicles. In fact, many cities use biofuels to power their bus systems. But what are the pros and cons of using biofuels?

Pros of biofuels: Unlike fossil fuels, which will run out one day, biofuels are renewable. As long as we can grow more crops, we can make more biofuel. Biofuels also cost less to make and to transport than fossil fuels do. Moreover, any country can make biofuel, and biofuel production in a country can mean jobs for its citizens.

Cons of biofuels: Biofuels don't contain as much energy as fossil fuels, which means more biofuels have to be used to create the same amount of power. In addition, making and using biofuels may create just as much carbon dioxide as using traditional fossil fuels, which would mean that biofuels would not be a sustainable solution for global warming. Finally, crops for biofuels can take up land that was being used to grow food and therefore can lead to an increase in the price of food.

You've probably sprained a joint like your wrist, elbow, or ankle at some point in your life. But what happens when you sprain a joint, and what can you do to recover from a sprain?

A sprain occurs when a ligament, the tough tissue that joins two bones together, is stretched too far. Ligaments cross over joints, and they can be overstretched when we move a joint in an awkward way. This overstretching causes some of the tissue in the ligament to tear. Once it tears, blood collects in the area of the joint, which causes it to swell. Special cells in the blood also release chemicals that help to remove the damaged tissue and to make new tissue.

To recover from a sprain, there are a few things that you can do. For the first two days, try not to move the joint. You should apply ice to it, wrap it, and keep it elevated. This will reduce the swelling and help the new ligament tissue to form. After two days, though, you should begin to use the sprained joint carefully. Doing so will help to strengthen the new tissue. If you follow these steps, you should make a full recovery.

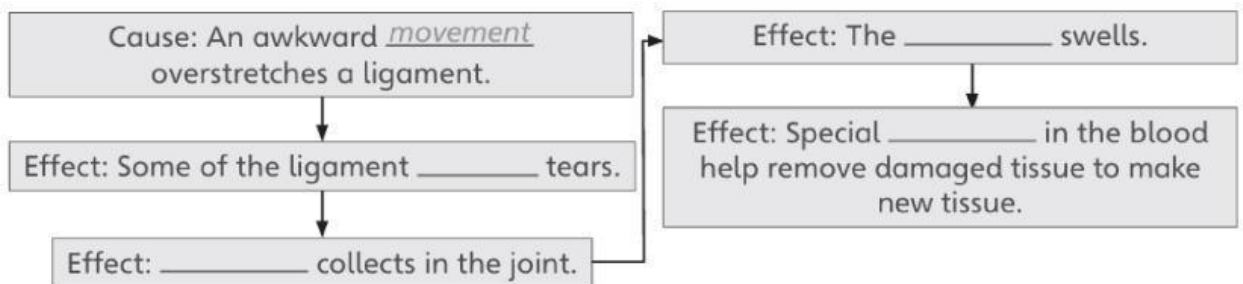
