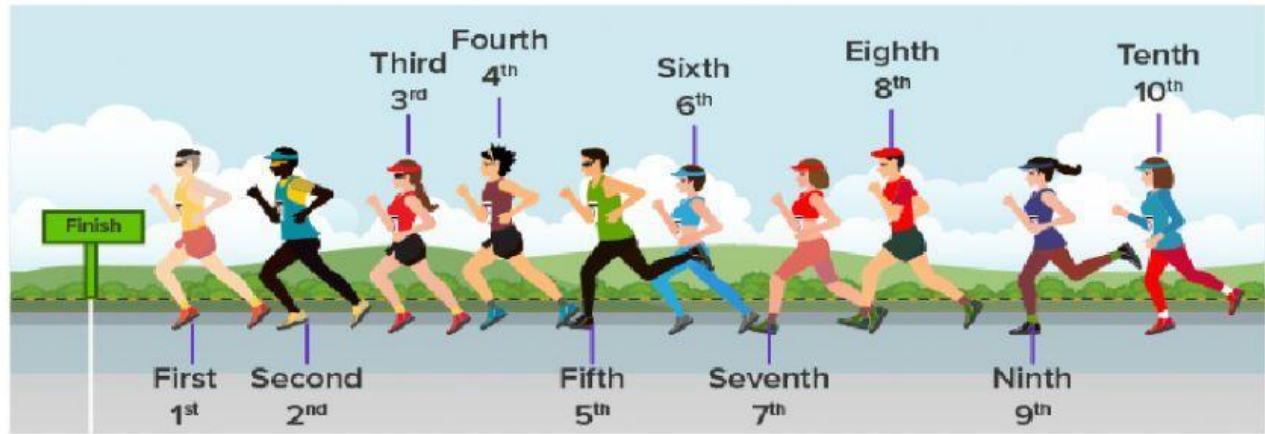




ORDINAL NUMBERS

We use ordinal numbers when we want to show the order or position of something or someone in a sequence.

We normally add a TH to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number.
Be careful of the spelling exceptions below:

1 st first	11 th eleventh	21 st twenty-first
2 nd second	12 th twelfth	22 nd twenty-second
3 rd third	13 th thirteenth	23 rd twenty-third
4 th fourth	14 th fourteenth	24 th twenty-fourth
5 th fifth	15 th fifteenth	25 th twenty-fifth
6 th sixth	16 th sixteenth	26 th twenty-sixth
7 th seventh	17 th seventeenth	27 th twenty-seventh
8 th eighth	18 th eighteenth	28 th twenty-eighth
9 th ninth	19 th nineteenth	29 th twenty-ninth
10 th tenth	20 th twentieth	30 th thirtieth

CENTURIES: Shakespeare was born in the **16th** century.

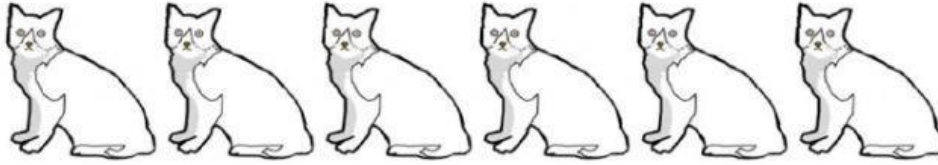
FLOORS OF A BUILDING: His office is on the **tenth** floor.

SEQUENCE/ORDER:

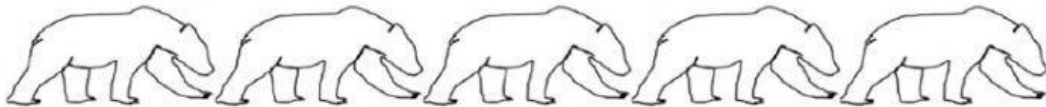
My team came **second** in the league.
