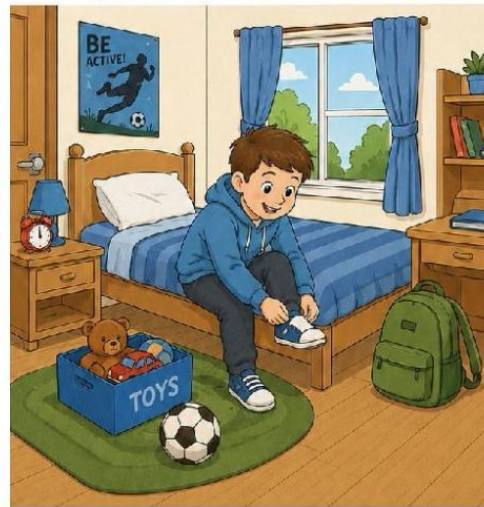
Phrasal Verbs – Reading
