

Comparative Adjective (2)

Rule	How to change	Examples
1. Most Adjectives	Add -er	small → smaller long → longer
2. Ending in <u>Consonant + y</u>	Drop -y, add -ier	happy → happier pretty → prettier
3. Ending in <u>1 vowel + 1 consonant</u>	Double final consonant, add -er	big → bigger hot → hotter
4. Irregular	No rules	good → better bad → worse
