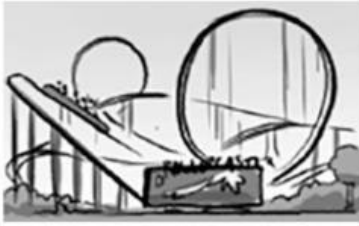

Great activities

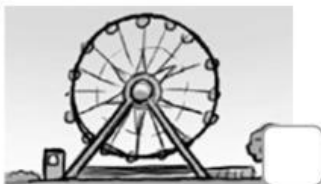

In the local town, there is a theatre and a museum. You can go bowling.

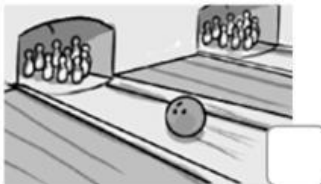
Have you ever visited a lighthouse? At the camp, you can visit the nearby lighthouse and climb the stairs to the top!
