#### I. Usage & Meaning:

### 3 WAYS TO USE SIMPLE PRESENT

USE	EXAMPLE
<p><b>1 Habits and routines</b> We use it for actions that happen regularly, habitually, or many times.</p> 	<p>• I <b>get up</b> at 6 o'clock every day.</p> 
<p><b>2 General truths and facts</b> We use it for facts that are always true, things that never change, or natural events.</p> 	<p>• The sun <b>rises</b> in the east.</p> 
<p><b>3 Schedules and timetables</b> We use it for events in the future that are part of a schedule, timetable, or program.</p> 	<p>• The bus <b>leaves</b> at 8 a.m. every day.</p> 

#### II. Form with action verbs

Subject	Positive (+)	Negative (-)	Question & Short answer
I/ You/ We/ They	S + Verb-inf eg: They <b>live</b> in Hanoi.	S + do not (don't) + V-inf eg: They <b>don't live</b> in Hue.	<b>Do + S + V-inf?</b> - Yes, S do - No, S do not (don't) <b>Do they live here?</b> → Yes, they <b>do</b> . / No, they <b>don't</b> .
He/ She/ It	S + V-s/-es eg: He <b>lives</b> in Hanoi.	S + does not (doesn't) + V-inf eg: He <b>doesn't live</b> in Hue.	<b>Does + Subject + V-inf?</b> - Yes, S does - No, S do not (doesn't) <b>Does he live here?</b> → Yes, he <b>does</b> . / No, he <b>doesn't</b> .

**✗ Crucial Spelling Rules for Third Person Singular**

- Most verbs: Add -s (walk → walks, read → reads)
- Verbs ending in -ch, -sh, -s, -x, -z, -o: Add -es (watch → watches, go → goes, fix → fixes)
- Verbs ending in *consonant* + -y: Change -y to -ies (study → studies, fly → flies)
