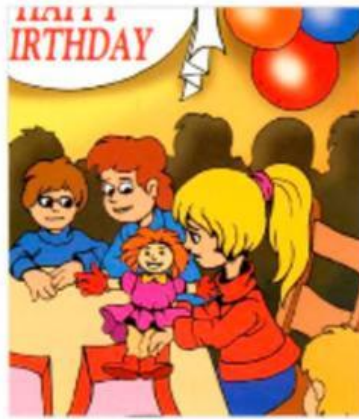
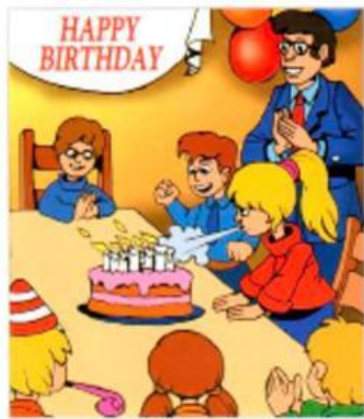


Empty light orange rounded rectangular box for writing the answer.
