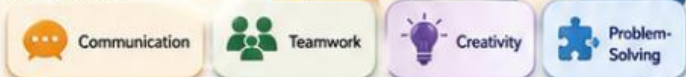
2 DIGITAL LITERACY IS ESSENTIAL

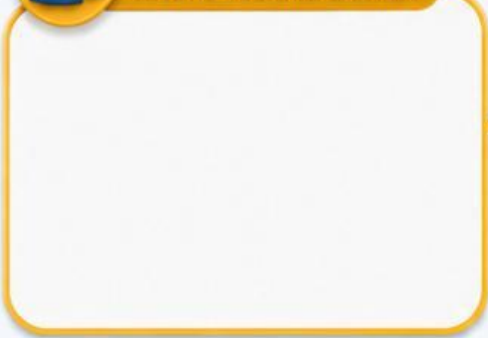

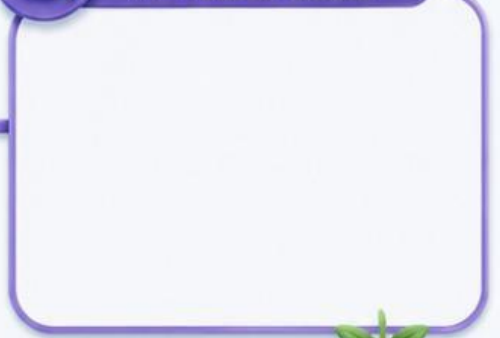

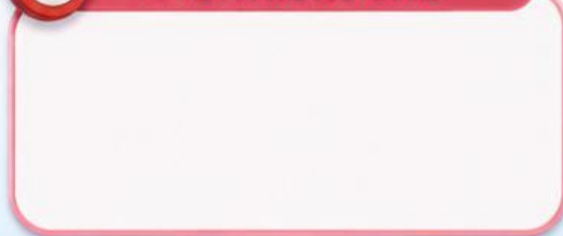
