First,

Then,

They remove the beans from the pods.

After that,

They ferment and dry the cacao beans.

Next,

They pack the dried beans and send them to factories.

Then,

Workers roast the beans.

After that,

They grind the roasted beans to make chocolate liquor.

Finally,

They turn the chocolate liquor into chocolate bars.
