

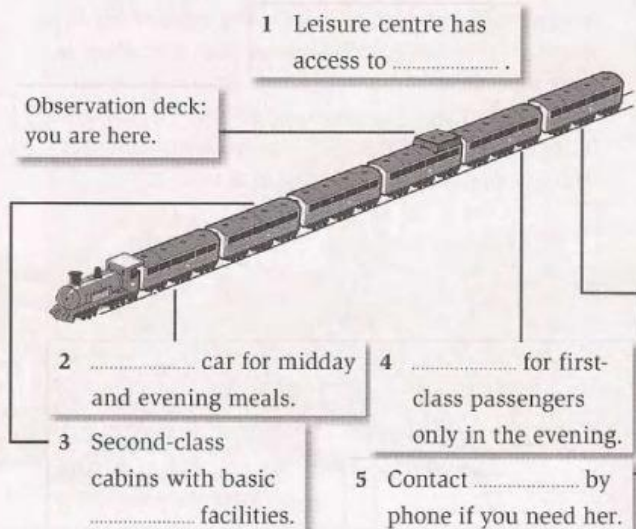

- 4 What do we call a room on a train or a ship where you sleep? Is it A a cell, B a cabin, C an office?

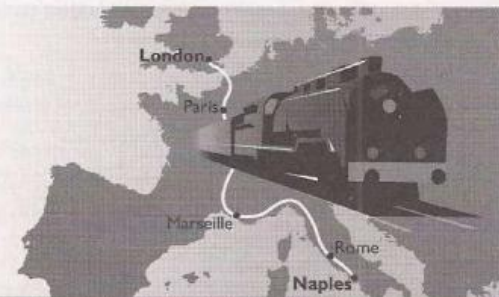
