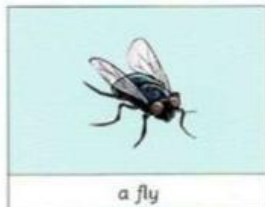
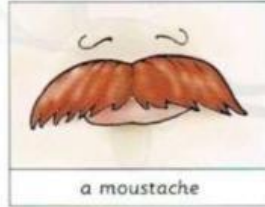
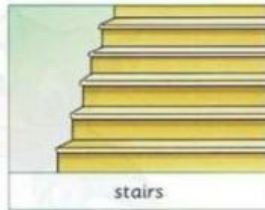
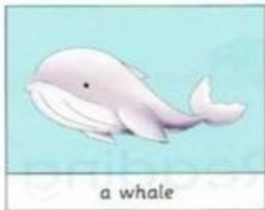


Exercise 1:
