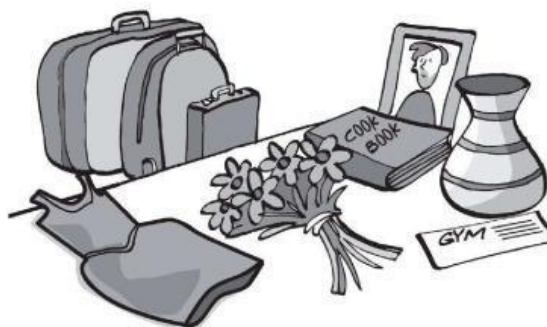

SIX GIFTS NOT TO GIVE YOUR WIFE OR GIRLFRIEND
