The traditional conical hat, known as "non la" in Vietnamese, is one of the most recognizable symbols of Vietnam's cultural heritage. For centuries, these hats have been an essential part of daily life, protecting people from the sun and

rain while working in the rice fields. The craft of making conical hats is a specialized skill that has been passed down through generations in many villages across the country. The most famous conical hat village is Chuong village, located in Hanoi's Thanh Oai district. Artisans there begin the process by selecting the right palm leaves, which must be dried in the sun until they turn white. The leaves are then ironed flat and cut into the proper shape. The frame of the hat is made from bamboo strips, carefully bent into circular rings of decreasing size. The artisan then skillfully sews the palm leaves onto the frame using thin threads, ensuring the hat is both durable and lightweight. A well-made conical hat can last for many years. In addition to its practical function, the conical hat has become an iconic image associated with Vietnamese women and traditional dress. Tourists visiting Vietnam often purchase conical hats as souvenirs, and many participate in workshops where they can try making one themselves. The conical hat industry provides stable employment for many rural communities and helps preserve an important aspect of Vietnamese cultural identity.
