Will	Instant decisions	A decision made at the moment of speaking.	<i>The phone is ringing. I'll answer it.</i>
Will	Offers	When offering to help someone.	<i>I'll carry your bags.</i>
Will	Promises	When making a promise or commitment.	<i>I will study harder.</i>
Will	Predictions (opinions)	Predictions based on personal opinion, belief, or guess.	<i>I think Colombia will win the match.</i>
Will	Requests	To ask someone politely to do something.	<i>Will you open the window, please?</i>
Be Going To	Plans	Actions or events already planned before speaking.	<i>We're going to visit our grandparents this weekend.</i>
Be Going To	Intentions	Something the speaker has already decided to do.	<i>She's going to study medicine.</i>
Be Going To	Predictions (evidence)	Predictions based on present evidence or visible signs.	<i>Look at those clouds! It's going to rain.</i>
