Each autumn, in many ethnic villages across the Northwest mountains, the corn harvest becomes one of the most important activities of the year. When the weather turns dry and the hillsides begin to glow with golden corn, local families prepare to start their work. People usually head to the fields early in the morning, because the slopes can be difficult to walk on under the strong afternoon sun. Corn is harvested completely by hand, and villagers check each cob carefully to make sure the kernels are firm and the husks are dry. After that, the cobs are pulled from the plants and collected in large bamboo baskets. On steep terraces, the baskets are carried down the hill with slow, steady steps. The work is tiring, but it is done with a calm and patient spirit that reflects the lifestyle of the community. During short breaks, villagers sit together under small wooden shelters, drink warm tea, and share stories about past seasons. Laughter often rises between the mountains, creating a warm atmosphere even during busy hours. For many ethnic groups, the corn harvest is not only a way to earn a living but also a tradition that strengthens family ties and keeps their culture alive.
