Usage	- Diễn tả thói quen thường nhật. <i>E.g: My father frequently watches the news on VTV3 at 7pm.</i> - Diễn tả lịch trình cố định. <i>E.g: The flight from HCMC to Singapore departs at 8am tomorrow.</i> - Diễn tả các hướng dẫn, chỉ dẫn . <i>E.g: First, you cut the strawberry into slices and put it on the cake.</i>	- Diễn tả hành động đang xảy ra tại thời điểm nói. <i>E.g: I'm laughing a lot.</i> - Diễn tả các tình huống tạm thời . <i>E.g: I'm staying with my aunt this month while my parents are abroad.</i> - Diễn tả sự phàn nàn với "always". <i>E.g: You are always chatting in class.</i> - Diễn tả các kế hoạch đã được sắp xếp hoặc thống nhất trong tương lai. <i>E.g: She's going to a tennis camp this summer.</i>
Dấu hiệu nhận biết	- Trạng từ chỉ tần suất : usually, often, frequently... - Cụm từ chỉ thời gian lặp lại : every, once/ twice/ ...times... - Cụm từ chỉ thời gian cố định : in the morning/ afternoon/ evening, at night/ at weekends...	- Trạng từ chỉ thời gian : now, at present, at the moment... - Câu mệnh lệnh : Look!, Listen!... - Từ cho câu phàn nàn : always, constantly, continually.
