

TO and FOR: Expressing Purpose

My Smartwatch

My name is Laura, and I use my smartwatch every day. I bought it because I wanted to make my daily life easier.

I use my smartwatch to check the time and to see my messages quickly. I also use it to count my steps and to track my exercise. In the morning, I use the alarm to wake up on time.

My smartwatch is also useful for exercise. I use it for tracking my heart rate and for counting my steps.

I sometimes use it for listening to music when I go for a walk.

I don't use my smartwatch only for fun. I use it to organize my day, to remember important appointments, and to stay active.

Grammar: Expressing Purpose with TO and FOR

We use to and for to explain the purpose of an action or thing. They answer: Why? / What is the purpose?

1. TO + BASE VERB

Use to + verb for the purpose of an action.

Examples: I use my phone to call my friends. / She went to the store to buy some food. / I use my smartwatch to track my exercise.

Remember: TO + VERB. ✓ to study ✓ to work ✓ to exercise. ✗ to studying ✗ to worked

2. FOR + NOUN

Use for + noun for the purpose of a thing or activity.

Examples: This app is for exercise. / This room is for meetings. / I use my phone for communication.

3. FOR + -ING

Use for + verb-ing to describe the function or purpose of a thing.

Examples: This app is for tracking your steps. / A smartwatch is useful for checking your heart rate. / This machine is for making coffee.

Important: After for, use the -ing form. ✓ for listening ✓ for studying ✗ for listen ✗ for study

TO vs. FOR

TO + Verb	FOR + Noun / -ing
I use my phone to call my mom.	I use my phone for communication.
I use my watch to track my steps.	I use my watch for tracking my steps.
She went to the gym to exercise.	The gym is for exercise.
He uses the computer to study.	The computer is for studying.
