Instructions: Read chapters 6 & 7 and answer the comprehension questions below. Also, practice reading the following text out loud—with English rhythm and pronunciation.

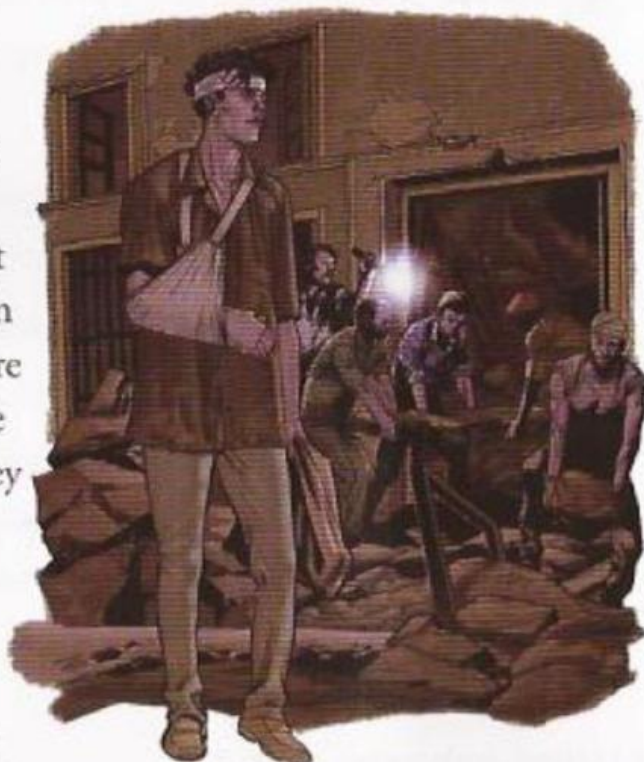
It was early in the morning when Gabriel arrived at the Delgados' flat. His arm hurt badly, and he was terribly thirsty.
