Dolly Parton – a timeline of her life and music

1946 – Dolly was born in Locust Ridge, Tennessee. She has 11 brothers and sisters. Her family didn't have much money, but they were happy.

1954 – Dolly started learning to play the guitar. Her uncle Bill helped her get started in writing songs.

1956 – At age 10, Dolly started singing and playing music on local radio and TV networks in Tennessee.

1964 – Dolly finished high school. She decided to move to Nashville to become a singer.

1967 – Dolly started working with the singer Porter Wagoner on his TV show.

1974 – Dolly decided to leave the TV show and release an album of her own songs. She wrote two of her most famous songs; *Jolene* and *I will always love you*, on the same day.

1980 – Dolly made her first film, *9 to 5*. She wrote the song *9 to 5* for the film.

1986 – Dolly opened her own theme park, Dollywood, in the area close to where she was born.

1990 – Dolly started a charity, The Imagination Library, to give free books to help children learn to read. Today the charity helps children in Canada, The UK, Ireland and Australia as well as the USA.

2010 – Dolly received a 'Lifetime achievement' Grammy award for her work in music, film and TV.

2019 – Dolly gave a special concert at the famous Grand Ole Opry to celebrate 50 years of membership.
