3. Indirect questions

Cách dùng	- Sử dụng để giao tiếp lịch sự, trang trọng hơn. - Sau cụm từ dẫn dắt , trật tự từ chuyển về dạng câu khẳng định và không dùng trợ động từ (do, does, did).	
Cụm từ dẫn dắt thường gặp	Could you tell me...? Do you know...? I was wondering... I'd like to know... ...	
Cấu trúc	*Dạng Wh-questions: Cụm từ dẫn dắt + Wh-word + S + V?	<i>E.g: Could you tell me where she lives?</i>
	*Dạng Yes/No questions: Cụm từ dẫn dắt + if / whether + S + V?	<i>E.g: Do you know if / whether he is coming to the meeting?</i>
Lưu ý	- Nếu cụm từ dẫn dắt là câu hỏi (Could you tell me...?), cuối câu dùng dấu hỏi (?). - Nếu cụm từ dẫn dắt là câu trần thuật (I was wondering...), cuối câu dùng dấu chấm (.).
