FOR PAST HABITS & STATES NO LONGER HAPPENING

[PAST (long ago)] ----- [NOW (present)]

1 PRIMARY USE: PAST HABITS & CHANGES

'USED TO'

'PRESENT TENSE'

Change of habit

I **USED TO** PLAY soccer

But **NOW I DON'T** PLAY

2 HOW IT'S FORMED (STRUCTURE)

SUBJECT + used to + VERB IN INFINITIVE
She **used to** LIVE in London

SUBJECT + didn't use to + VERB IN INFINITIVE
They **didn't use to** LIKE broccoli
Note: "used to" becomes "use to" after "didn't"

Did + SUBJECT + use to + VERB IN INFINITIVE?
Did YOU **use to** HAVE a dog?

3 DIFFERENT FROM "BE USED TO"

USED TO (+ INFINITIVE)
Used to do
I **USED TO** PLAY soccer
For past habits.

"BE USED TO" (+ GERUND / NOUN)
Be accustomed to / Be familiar with
I **AM USED TO** walking in the rain
For present familiarity.
