## THE KING OF THE SUN (RADEN PUTRA)

A king named Lambung Mangkurat from Nagara Dipa, dreamt of the perfect husband for his daughter, Princess Junjung Buih. The dream pointed him towards the King of Majapahit, who had a miraculously born son, Raden Putra.

Determined, Lambung Mangkurat traveled to Majapahit and secured Raden Putra's hand in marriage. However, their journey by ship was mysteriously halted by a powerful white dragons sent by Princess Junjung Buih. Taking charge, the brave Raden Putra jumped into the sea to face the dragon.
