'These are tomato plants,' said Grandpa. 'You can make a garden on a balcony with these.'

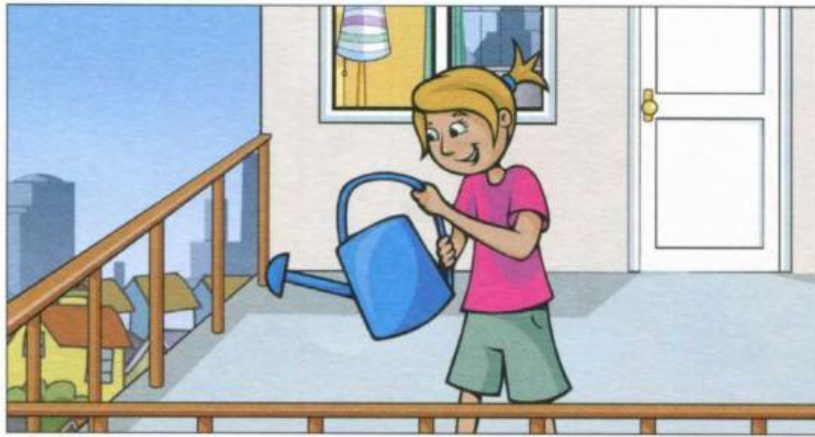

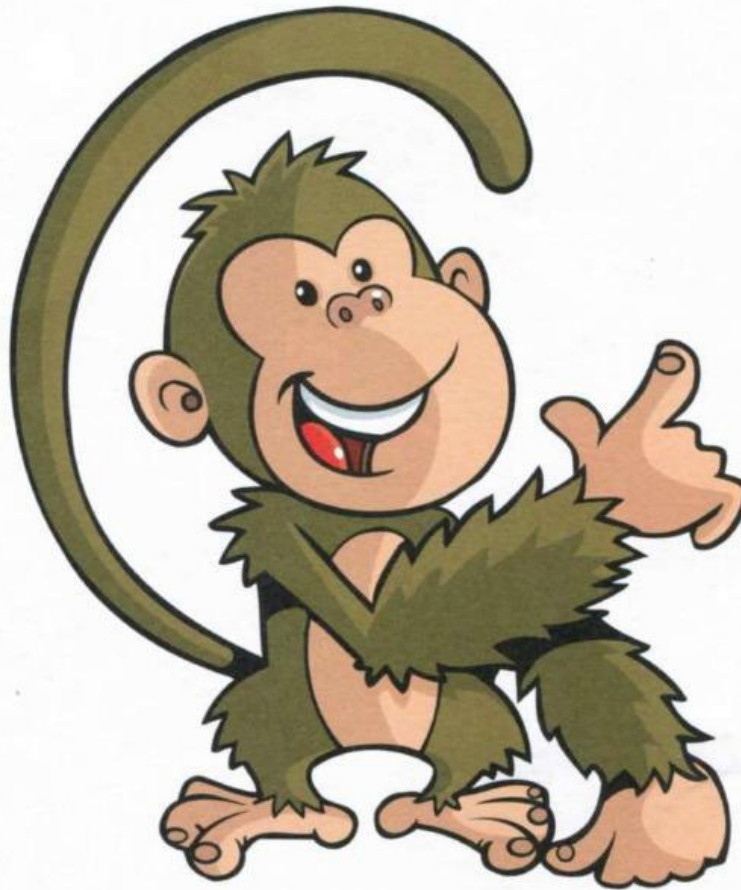

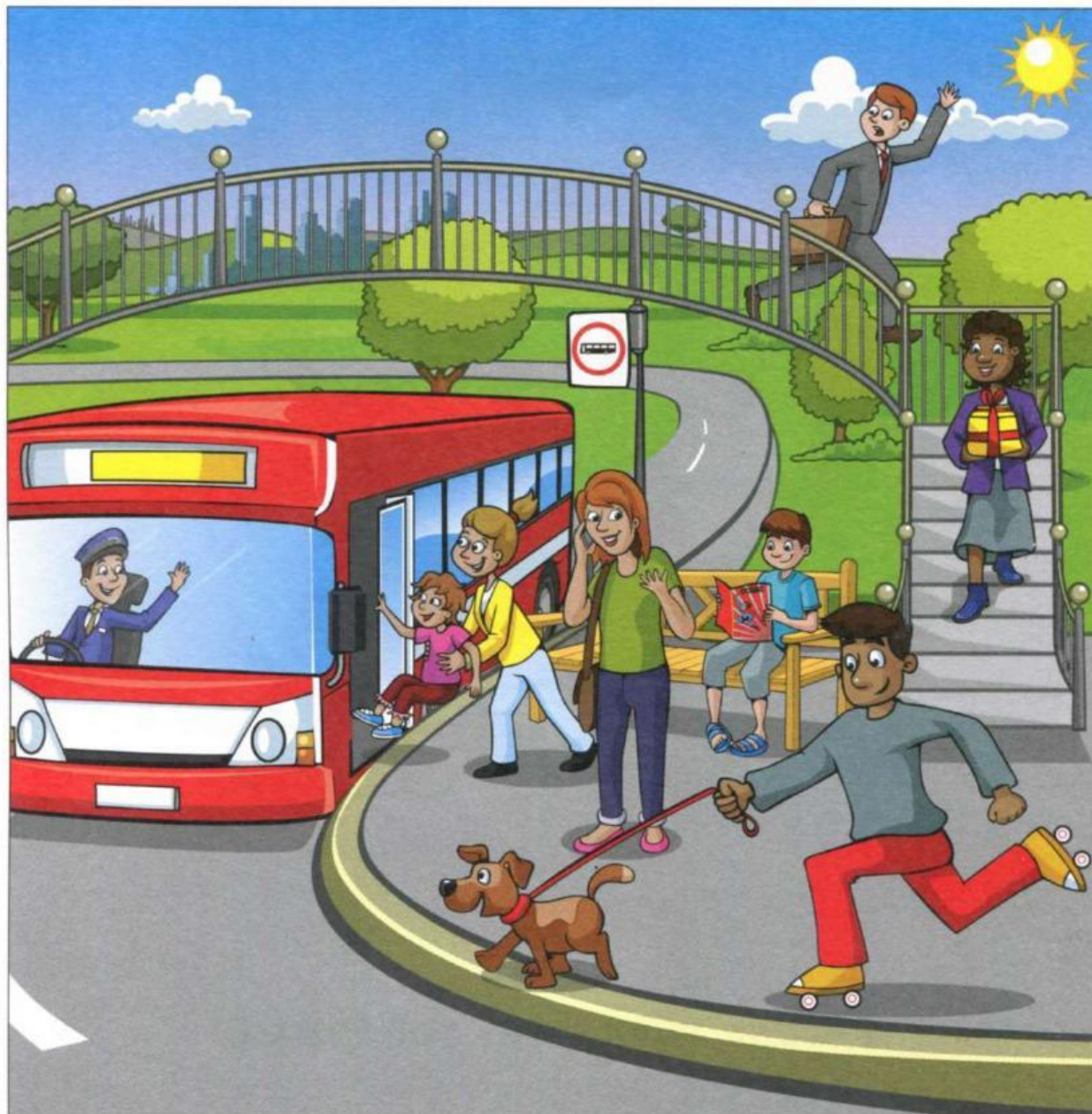
