It does **not** need to be perfect.

Your goal is to **communicate an idea**, not to speak perfect English.

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## BEFORE YOU RECORD

Before pressing **Record**, check:

- ☐ I know my topic.
- ☐ I know what I want to say.
- ☐ I can speak without reading every word.
- ☐ I am speaking loudly and clearly.
- ☐ I am in a relatively quiet place.
- ☐ My phone is recording.
- ☐ I am ready to make mistakes and keep going!

**Remember:**

**Don't worry about being perfect.**

**Speak clearly.**

**Take your time.**

**Express your idea.**

**Be yourself.**



## RECORD YOUR VOICE

**Your challenge:**

Record **30–45 seconds**.

You can begin:

**"Hi, I'm \_\_\_\_\_. Today I'd like to talk about..."**

**Embed your recording here:** \_\_\_\_\_

**Important rule:**

**Don't read a complete paragraph.**

You may use your prompts and keywords, but try to **speak naturally**.

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### LISTEN TO YOUR OWN VOICE

This is an important part of the activity.

Listen to your recording **once without judging your English**.

Then answer:

What would you like to do in the future?

What will the world be like?

What would you like to learn?

### **SOMETHING UNUSUAL**

Do you know a strange story?

Have you ever heard something mysterious?

Why do people find it interesting?

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★ Three levels of speaking support

● LEVEL A1 — “I CAN SAY IT”

**You can use:**

My name is...

I like...

My favorite... is...

I am interested in...

I like it because...

I want to talk about...

**Target:** approximately **20–30 seconds** if necessary.

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● LEVEL A2 — “I CAN EXPLAIN IT”

**Encourage:**

I became interested in... because...

I usually...

One interesting thing about... is...

I think... because...

I would recommend... because...

**Target:** **30–45 seconds**.

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● LEVEL B1 — “I CAN DEVELOP AN IDEA”

**Include:**

One reason I'm interested in this topic is...

Something people don't know about it is...

In my opinion...

What makes this interesting is...

I would like to find out more about...
