Ví dụ 2: Whose backpack is it? – It's her backpack.

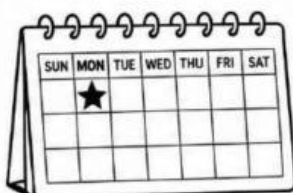
