2 I need electricity to work. You can play with me. You can also work with me. I am made of plastic, metal and glass. You can send messages through me. What am I?



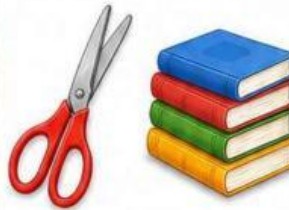
3 I can be soft or hard. I can be pink, orange, yellow etc. I am cold. Children usually like me. My favourite place is the freezer. What am I?
