SHORT MATERIAL REVIEW

Recount Text

Recount text is a text which retells about events or experiences in the past.

(Teks recount adalah teks yang menceritakan kembali tentang kejadian atau pengalaman di masa lalu.)

Generic structures of Recount Text

- 1. Orientation** : Introducing the participants, place and time
- 2. Record of Events** : Describing the events in chronological order
- 3. Comment/Re-orientation** : Stating personal comment or impression of the story

Identifying Specific Information in Recount Text

Specific information = *informasi tertentu yang terdapat dalam teks.*

To find specific information, look for 5w + 1H :

- **What?** → **apa** yang terjadi
- **Who?** → **siapa** yang terlibat
- **When?** → **kapan** kejadian terjadi
- **Where?** → **di mana** kejadian terjadi
- **How?** → **bagaimana** kejadiannya
