Business Trips



A HAVE + PERSON + BASE VERB

We ask or arrange for someone to do something.



Paul had a mechanic **repair** his car.

B HAVE + THING + PAST PARTICIPLE

We ask for a service to be done.



Paul had his car **repaired**.

A = have + person + base verb

B = have + thing + past participle
