The Dance of Honeybees

Honeybees live in well-organized colonies and depend on one another to find food. When a worker bee discovers a rich source of nectar, it returns to the hive and performs a special movement called the waggle dance. The bee moves in a figure-eight pattern while shaking its body. The direction of the dance shows other bees where to fly in relation to the sun, and the length of the waggle tells them how far away the flowers are. A longer waggle usually means a greater distance.

The dancing bee also carries the scent of the flowers on its body. Other workers touch it with their antennae and learn what kind of flower to search for. They then leave the hive and follow the information from the dance. This system helps the colony collect food efficiently without every bee having to search

randomly. However, cloudy weather and strong wind can make the journey more difficult, so bees may adjust their flight path as conditions change.
