Describing Pictures: Present Continuous Tense

Part 1: Remember

When do we use it? We use the Present Continuous to describe actions happening right now at the moment of speaking or to describe what people are doing in a picture.

Affirmative Structure:

Subject + am / is / are + Verb-ing

- **I am (I'm)** studying English.
- **He / She / It is (He's / She's)** reading a book.
- **We / You / They are (They're)** playing football.

Spelling Tip (-ing):

- Most verbs: add **-ing** (*listen -> listening, eat -> eating*)
- Verbs ending in silent **-e**: remove the -e (*write -> writing, dance -> dancing*)
- Short vowel + consonant: double the last consonant (*run -> running, swim -> swimming*)
