PARTICIPLE ADJECTIVES – TÍNH TỪ -ING / -ED

	Adjectives ending in -ING	Adjectives ending in -ED
Cách dùng	Mô tả người, vật hoặc tình huống gây ra một cảm xúc.	Mô tả cảm xúc/trạng thái của một người khi chịu tác động từ người, vật hoặc tình huống khác.
Câu hỏi để nhớ	What is it/someone like? – Nó/người đó như thế nào?	How does someone feel? – Người đó cảm thấy thế nào?
Cấu trúc thường gặp	S + be + adj-ing / adj-ing + noun	S + be / feel / get + adj-ed
Ví dụ	The film is boring. It is a boring film. The instructions are confusing. Alex is an annoying person.	We are bored with the film. The students feel confused. I am annoyed with Alex.

Cách phân biệt

-ING → causes the feeling

→ người/vật/tình huống gây ra cảm xúc.

The news was surprising.

→ Tin tức gây ngạc nhiên.

-ED → experiences the feeling

→ người trải qua/cảm nhận cảm xúc đó.

We were surprised by the news.

→ Chúng tôi cảm thấy ngạc nhiên.
