Write the affirmative form of present continuous.

Look at the picture for the correct form of the verb to be **Is, Are, Am.**

Subject	Helping Verb	Examples
 I	am	→ I am studying.
 He  She  It	is	→ He is playing. → She is cooking. → It is raining.
 You  We  They	are	→ You are listening. → We are working. → They are talking.

Example: I / sweep the floor.

Answer: I **am** sweeping the floor.

Example: Paty / water plants

Paty isn't watering the plants.

I / wake up.

My dad / take a shower

My sister / get dressed

They / have breakfast

My brother / leave home at 7 am.

We / take the bus

I / arrive at school at 8 am.

Peter / brush his teeth

Negative

I'm not playing.

You're not reading.

He isn't driving.

She isn't running.

It isn't barking.

We aren't watching.

They aren't cooking.

Write the question form of present continuous

Example: They / feed the dog.

Are they feeding the dog?

I / wake up.

My dad / take a shower

My sister / get dressed

They / have breakfast

My brother / leave home at 7 am.

We / take the bus

I / arrive at school at 8 am.

Question

Am I playing?

Are you reading?

Is he driving?
