STARTING POINT: RAWSON SQUARE

DIRECTIONS:

1. **START AT RAWSON SQUARE.**
2. **FACE EAST AND TRAVEL ALONG BAY STREET.**
3. **CONTINUE UNTIL YOU REACH PARLIAMENT SQUARE.**
4. **TURN RIGHT AND HEAD SOUTH ALONG THE STREET BESIDE PARLIAMENT SQUARE.**
5. **CONTINUE UNTIL YOU REACH SHIRLEY STREET.**
6. **LOOK FOR THE OCTAGONAL BUILDING ASSOCIATED WITH BOOKS, READING, AND HISTORY.**
7. **WHAT PLACE DID YOU FIND?**
