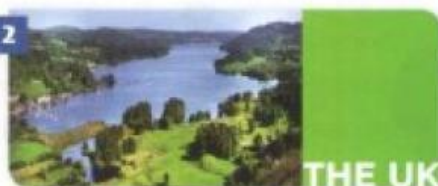

TIMANFAYA NATIONAL PARK



Timanfaya National Park on the island of Lanzarote includes an active volcano. The beauty of this wilderness area **lies in** its rugged rock formations and its treeless landscapes, framed by the blue waters of the Atlantic. The park can become very busy during high season, so you are advised to apply in advance to schedule your visit. One of the activities you can book is a guided camel tour of the sights.

LAKE DISTRICT NATIONAL PARK



The Lake District may not be the biggest national park in the UK, but it is one of the most visited. It covers a huge area of natural beauty, which includes not only lakes and rolling hills, but also quaint towns to visit. Grab a map, head in any direction, and you won't be disappointed. Wherever you end up, you will probably not be far from one of the traditional pubs for which the region is famous.

DANUBE DELTA TRANSBOUNDARY BIOSPHERE RESERVE



The Danube Delta is an extraordinary network of lakes and islands which is home to hundreds of protected bird species, including 70% of the world's white pelicans. Birdwatchers and scientists come here from around the world for the breathtaking sight of thousands of birds descending on the Delta as part of their yearly migration. On the Ukrainian side, visitors can enjoy reasonably priced birdwatching boat tours through its winding waterways.

TRIGLAV NATIONAL PARK



Triglav is a popular hiking and climbing destination with stunning mountain scenery, sculpted by rivers and waterfalls. It is also one of the oldest nature reserves in Europe, sharing a border with Italy. It is free to enter the park, as there are only entrance fees to access certain locations, such as the Savica Waterfall. Visit one of several information centres and learn everything you need to know about your visit to Triglav National Park.

ÉCRINS NATIONAL PARK



Écrins National Park is best experienced through a multi-day hike, though even those who choose to spend just a few hours will be amazed by its high alpine scenery. This park is vast, with over 700 km of marked trails that reach 60 lakes and a staggering number of snow-covered peaks. Since 2000, the park's scientific team has been monitoring the glaciers in the park in an effort to better understand climate change.

THE BLACK FOREST NATIONAL PARK



Though it covers a relatively small area, the Black Forest is a very diverse ecosystem. Its fairy-tale landscape was shaped by glaciers, which existed in the area millions of years ago in the ice age. The park is dotted with steep canyons and rock formations. About 70% of the park's surface area is covered by forest, while another 25% is **used for** agricultural purposes. Camping in the forest is a special treat for anyone who can fit it into their schedule.
