#### From a Difficult Childhood to a Remarkable Life

*Gifted Hands: The Ben Carson Story* is based on the true story of **Dr. Ben Carson**, who grew up in Detroit and struggled at school. He did not believe he was a particularly intelligent student, but his mother, Sonya, believed in him. She encouraged Ben and his brother to read more and spend less time watching television.

Little by little, Ben's attitude toward learning changed. His grades improved, and he became interested in science and medicine. He later studied at Yale University and medical school before becoming a neurosurgeon at Johns Hopkins Hospital.

Carson became famous for performing complex brain surgeries. In 1987, he led a team that successfully separated twins who were joined at the back of the head. He retired from medicine in 2013 after almost three decades as a surgeon.

But his story continued. From 2017 to 2021, Carson served as the **U.S. Secretary of Housing and Urban Development**. Today, he is no longer a

practicing neurosurgeon, but he continues to write, speak publicly, and share his experiences.

Ben Carson's story is about more than becoming a doctor. It shows how education, support, discipline, and determination can change the way a person sees their own future.
