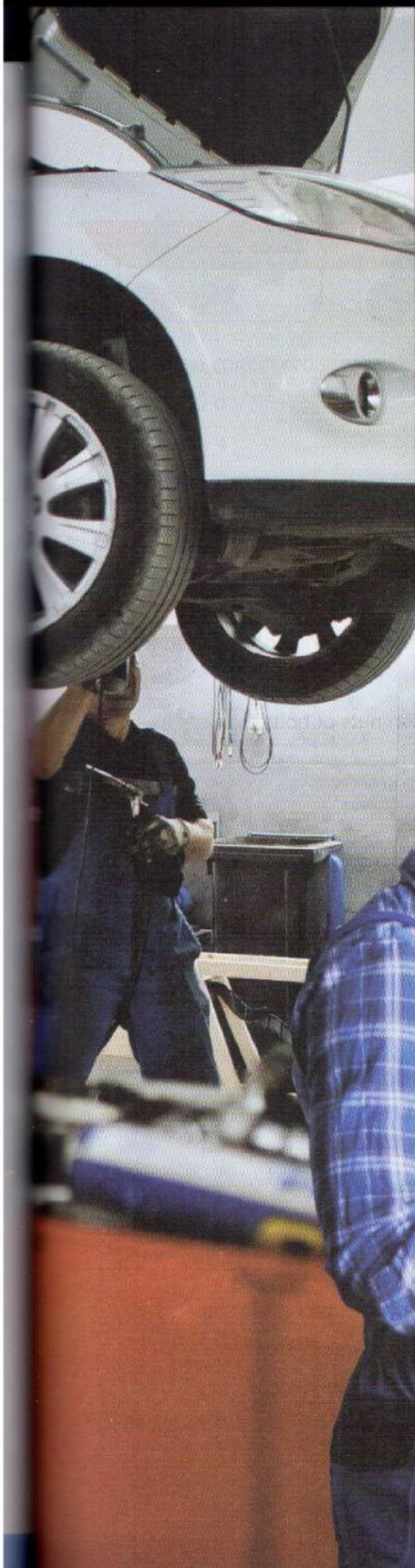

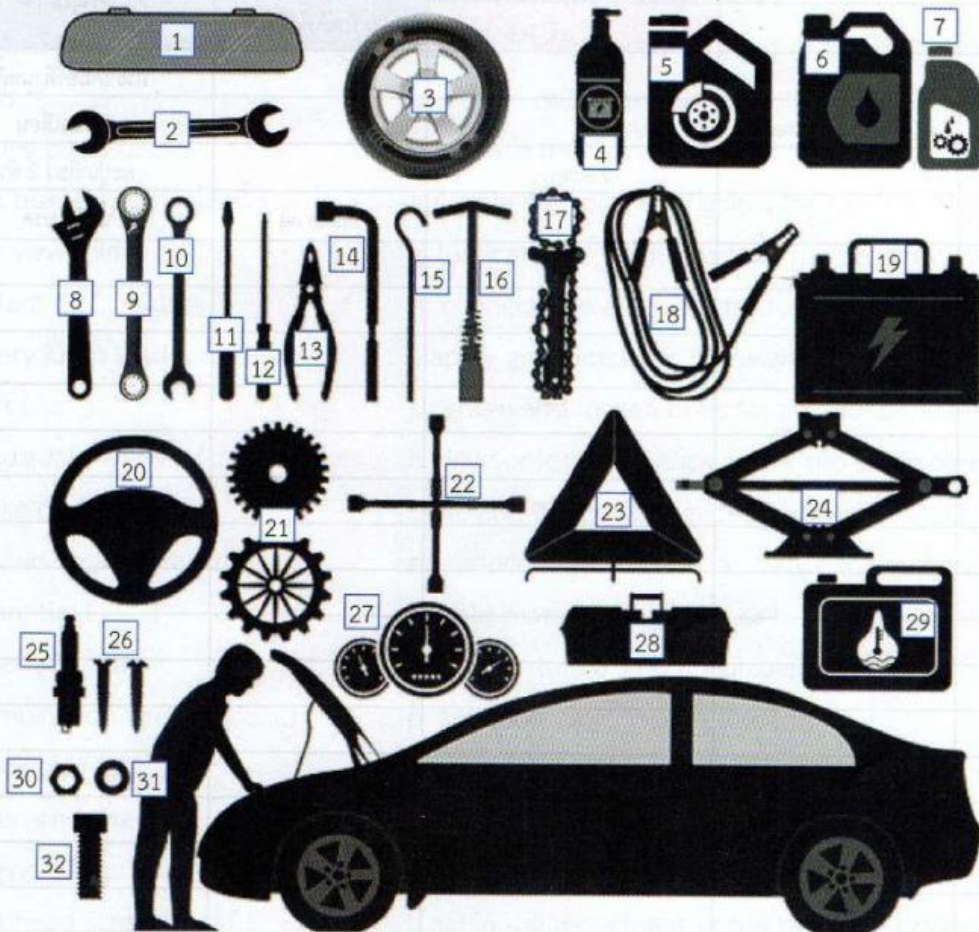

Imperative Sentences with Sequence Adverbs

การใช้ Imperative Sentence

Imperative sentence (ประโยคคำสั่ง/ ประโยคขอร้อง) คือประโยคที่ใช้ในการให้คำแนะนำหรือบอกวิธีการปฏิบัติงานต่าง ๆ โดยไม่ต้องมีประธานนำหน้าประโยค

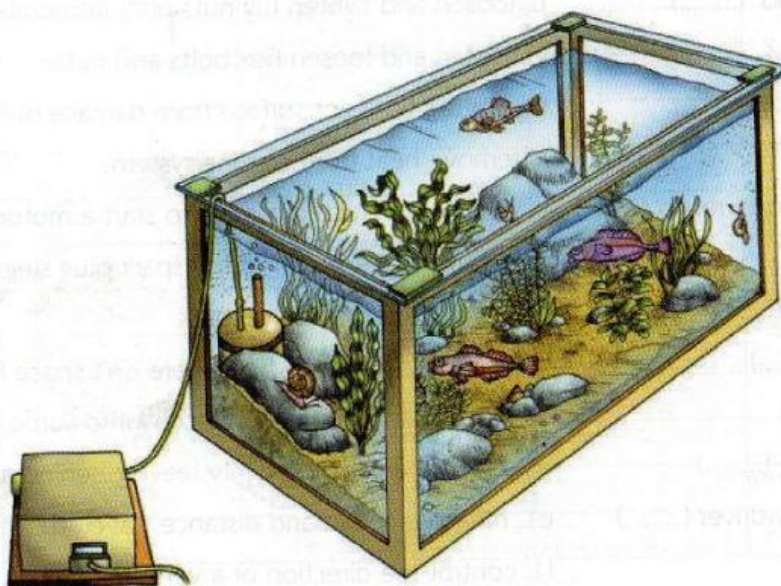
โครงสร้างประโยค

ประโยคคำสั่งสามารถนำ Sequence Adverbs มาขยายในประโยคเพื่อบอกลำดับการปฏิบัติงานโดยวางไว้หน้าประโยค

Sequence Adverbs + Base form of verb (กริยาช่องที่ 1) + Object + Complement

Example

Sequences Adverbs (กริยาวิเศษณ์บอกลำดับ)	Verb1	Object (กรรม)	Complement (ส่วนเติมเต็มประโยค)
First	attach	one end of your airline	to the air pump.
Then	attach	a stone filter	to the end of the airline.
Next	place	a stone filter	into the fish tank.
Finally	plug in	the air pump	to power.

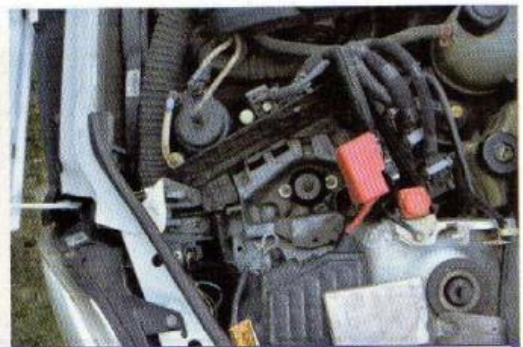

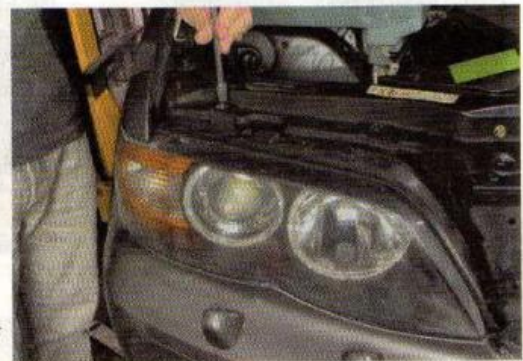

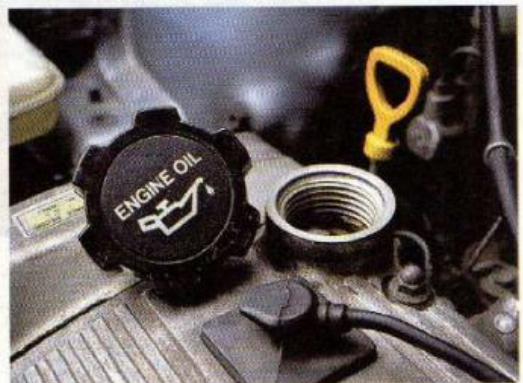
b. Replace a car headlight bulb

-, place the oil drain pan underneath the engine drain plug.
-, check oil levels by pulling out the dipstick.

Instruction 1

Replacing Motorcycle Spark Plugs

Use your fingers to remove the wires from the spark plugs. Use a ratchet wrench and a spark plug socket to turn the spark plugs in a counter - clockwise direction until they are loose. Blow out the cylinder heads with compressed air. Insert the new spark plug and tighten with a ratchet wrench. Reinstall the motorcycle's spark-plug wires. It is vitally important to put the wires back in the right place.

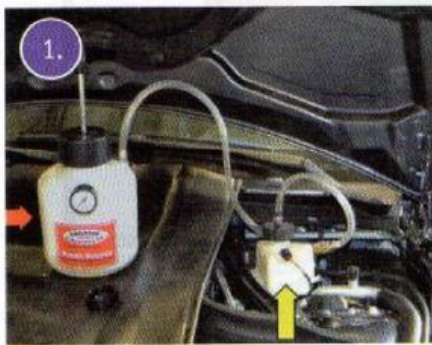
Taking Care of Hydraulic Brakes

You will need to clean any sludge out of the brake system. Refill with brake fluid. Remove all trapped air from your brakes while changing fluids. Clean break carefully without leaving any residue that causes your brakes to work improperly. Replace the brake pads. Check the connections and condition of all cords.

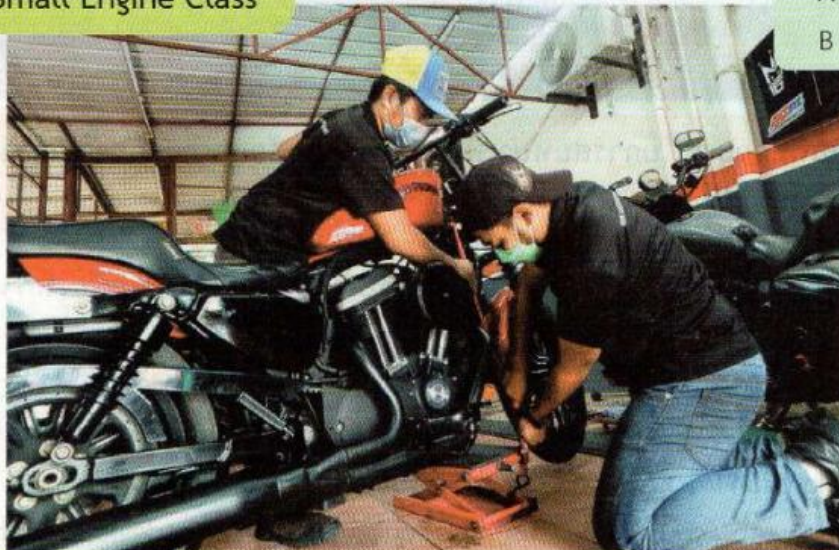

- How can I/ you use? (this equipment/ machine/device; a washing machine)
 - How can I/ you operate? (this equipment/ machine/device)
 - How can I/ you make? (something; a tasty sandwich)
 - How can I/ you repair? (this equipment/ machine/ device; a washing machine)
 - How can I/ you? (perform work; align tires)

Example

Ask : How can I make a tasty sandwich?

Answer :

- First, place one slice of bread on a plate.
- Then, apply a spread to one slice of your bread.
- Next, place protein foods on top of your spread.
- After that, pile on fruits or vegetables.
- Finally, place the remaining slice of bread on top and enjoy!
