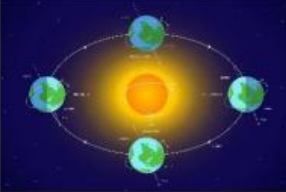

Explanation	Things that are always true	Fixed public/academic times	Actions repeated regularly
Examples	• The Earth goes around the Sun.	• The library opens at 8:00 AM.	• I wake up at 6:30 AM every morning.

II. FORM

1. Affirmative Form

Subject	Verb Form	Example
I / You / We / They / Danh từ số nhiều	V (bare)	• We study business administration.
He / She / It / Danh từ số ít	V-s / -es / -ies	• She works in an international bank.

2. Negative Form

Subject	Auxiliary + not	Verb (bare)	Example
I / You / We / They	do not (don't)	V (nguyên mẫu)	• I don't drink coffee at night.
He / She / It	does not (doesn't)	V (nguyên mẫu)	• She doesn't drive to campus.

3. Yes/No Questions (Thử nghĩ vấn)

Do / Does	Subject	Verb (bare)	Short Answers
Do	you / they / we	live near campus?	• Yes, I/they do . / No, I/they don't .
Does	he / she / it	speak English?	• Yes, he/she does . / No, he/she doesn't .
