Time clauses

Time clauses describe the timing of actions or events and are headed by subordinating conjunctions like *when*, *before*, *after*, *as soon as*, *while*, *until*, and *once*. Past time clauses describe actions that ended in the past. They often use past tenses. Future time clauses describe actions that will happen in the future. They often use present tenses or future expressions.

Past	Future
I lived in India before I moved here.	I'll read a book after I finish my chores.
I came as soon as I heard.	I will get there as soon as I can.
She made a mess while I was not looking.	The dinner won't be ready until dad gets here.
He was sick until he met a new doctor.	I'll be lonely until you come back.
He was a good worker once he learned the rules.	I'll put things away once I figure out where I want them.
