|                          | Rule       | Example                                  |
|--------------------------|------------|------------------------------------------|
| Most Verbs               | + -s       | • play → plays      • read → reads       |
| -s, -sh, -ch, -x, -o, -z | + -es      | • watch → watches    • go → goes         |
| Consonant + y            | - y + -ies | • fly → flies          • study → studies |
