The centre offers weekend activities as well as end-of-the-year holiday camps. Weekend activities include bird-watching, skateboarding, hiking, rock climbing, painting and photography. These half-day activities are held on either Saturday or Sunday. Each activity costs RM75. The fee includes equipment, instructors' service charge and lunch.

Accompanied by trained and skilled instructors, participants will camp out in the jungle. Their days and sometimes, night time will be occupied with activities. Graphic Novels VS Comic Books

There have been times when the word 'comics' was used to refer to comic books and graphic novels. But, both have some significant differences.

Comic books are magazines. (33) Graphic novels are single publications. However, some publishers have produced a series of graphic novels. For example, Marvel Comics published a series of 35 works between 1982 and 1988.

Comic books may have a single story or maybe two or three stories in an issue. The characters in all these stories may or may not be the same. (34)

Another difference is the length. Comic books have a fixed number of pages. In the early 1940s, they were between 64 and 96 pages. (35) However, there are numerous comic book series with a special longer issue which is published once a year. (36) It ranges between 60 and 500 pages.

A Story of Survival

In 1992, Colby Coombs decided to climb Mount Foraker in Alaska with his two friends, Ritt Kellogg and Tom Walter. Coombs was 25 years old and worked as a National Outdoor Leadership School instructor. The three men were on a holiday in Alaska Range when they set out to climb the 5,303 m mountain.

They trekked without much obstacles until they came close to the summit. (37) However, the only way back was risky.

The friends were only tied to each other as they began to move across the face. (38) A massive pile of snow rushed down and knocked them to about 240 m down the side of the mountain.

Coombs remembered sliding down quickly. Then, he hit something and went flying into the air. (39)

Coombs awoke six hours later. He found himself dangling near a mass of rock sticking out of a mountain. Coombs did not slip down further because his friend, Tom Walter, who was on the other side. He swung over to Tom but he was dead. Coombs was devastated. The following day, Coombs struggled to make his way down the mountain. (40)

Over the next few days, Coombs suffered extreme pain from his injuries and the loss of his friends as he hiked down the mountain. In the end, Coombs reached a safer place and made a full recovery. He now runs a mountaineering school in his hometown in Alaska.
