Types of fractions

Fourth Grade - Teacher Begonia

Fractions can be classified as proper fractions, improper fractions or mixed numbers.

- A proper fraction is a fraction where the numerator is less than the denominator.
- An improper fraction (or top-heavy fraction) is a fraction where the numerator is greater than (or equal to) the denominator.
- A mixed number has a whole number and a fraction.

To convert improper fractions to mixed numbers you may need to remember:

With an **Improper fraction** ...

Division is the **Action!**

Divide the **numerator** by the **denominator**.

numerator	13
denominator	5

		2	→ quotient is the whole number
divisor is the denominator ←	5	13	
	-	10	
		3	→ remainder is the numerator

$$\frac{13}{5} = 2 \frac{3}{5}$$

Convert an improper fraction to a mixed number.

$\frac{7}{2} =$	$\frac{13}{3} =$	$\frac{21}{6} =$
$\frac{4}{3} =$	$\frac{45}{7} =$	$\frac{35}{4} =$

To convert a mixed number to an improper fraction you may need to remember:

How to make Mixed Numbers

mad?

$$3 + \frac{1}{5} = \frac{(5 \times 3) + 1}{5} = \frac{16}{5}$$

Step 1: *Multiply the denominator by the whole number. (denominator x whole)*

Step 2: *Add numerator to the product. (denominator x whole) + numerator*

Step 3: *Write the same DENOMINATOR*

Convert a mixed number to an improper fraction.

$$4 \frac{1}{2} =$$

$$4 \frac{1}{3} =$$

$$2 \frac{3}{8} =$$

$$3 \frac{4}{6} =$$

$$5 \frac{4}{8} =$$
