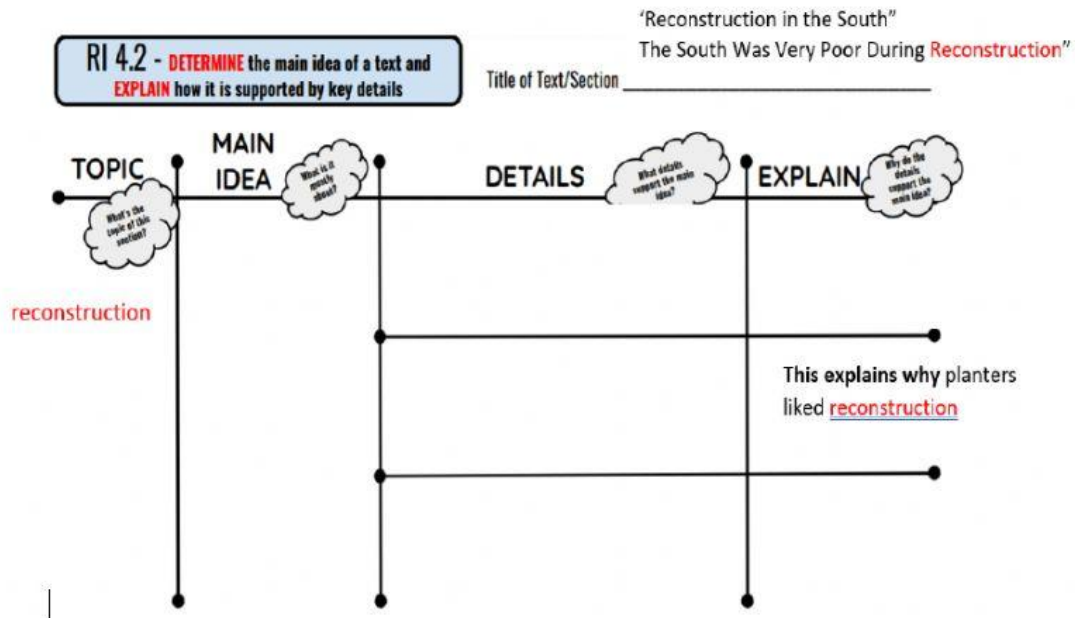


Use the drag and drop feature to complete the graphic organizer with information from an excerpt (section one) from **“Reconstruction in the South”**

The main idea of this section is The South was extremely (very) poor during reconstruction

- Planters did not have a lot of money
- Did not pay wages
- Sharecropping kept African Americans poor
- Bad harvests (crops) hurt blacks and whites

- African Americans didn't have their own money or land
- African Americans had to become sharecroppers
