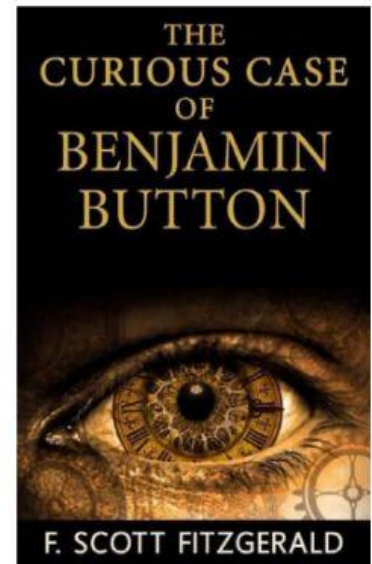
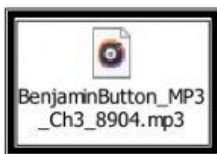


THE CURIOUS CASE OF BENJAMIN BUTTON
