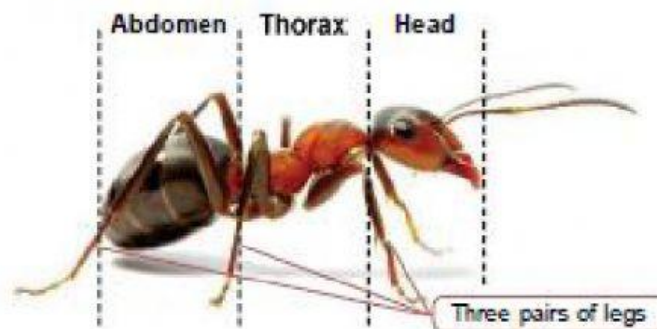


Activity 2 : Is the ant an insect?

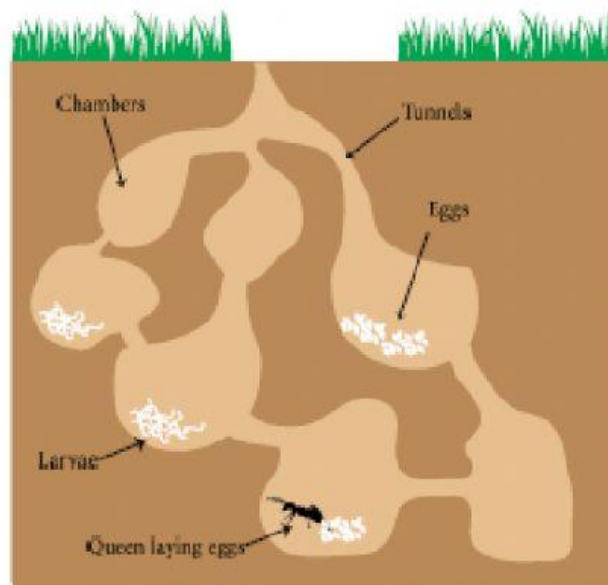
► Observe the figure, read the text, think then answer the questions.

Ants are social insects like bees.
These social insects form colonies,
called anthills containing from tens
to millions of ants.



A- The anthill

The anthill is composed of a heap of
soil and various materials from the
forest. Inside, there are many tunnels and
chambers. The construction of an anthill is very organized.
The surface of an anthill is covered with pine needles and leaves of trees.



B- The inhabitants of the anthill

In a colony, there are three kinds of ants: workers, males and queens.
The ants of a colony have different roles.



The Queen

Generally, there is only one queen in an ant colony. It is the biggest of all the ants and the only one that lays eggs. Some queens can lay millions of eggs during their life that lasts between 10 to 15 years.



The Male

There are only a few males in the colony and have only one task, fertilizing the queen. Males have wings.



The Worker

The workers are the most numerous. They are females without wings, they are the smallest of the colony, but they do almost all the work. They go for food, they build and maintain the ant-hill, and they take care of the eggs and young ants.
