adjective	comparative	
old cheap	older cheaper	
big hot	bigger hotter	
dry healthy	drier healthier	
famous expensive	<b>more</b> famous <b>more</b> expensive	
good bad far	better worse further	

two- or more syllable adjectives: **more** + adjective

one-syllable adjectives: add **-er**

irregular

adjectives ending one vowel + one consonant: double consonant, add **-er**

one- or two-syllable adjectives ending consonant + y > **-ier**
