Origin of EASTER

Easter is now a Christian festival but it is thought to be Pagan in origin. The word "Easter" comes from "Eostre", the name for the goddess of spring.

Easter Day falls on the first Sunday after the full moon following the 21st of March (spring). It is always between 22nd of March and 25th of April.

Many animals like baby sheep, rabbits, birds and chicks are born in the spring. These animals are symbols of Easter.

Eggs are an important part of Easter because they represent new life.

On Easter Sunday, people give chocolate Easter eggs as presents.

There's a game children play on Easter. The Easter bunny hides chocolate eggs and children have to search for them.
